and to Farnsfield Pre-School



Sessions and Funding

Sessions: We offer 3 hr morning and afternoon sessions each weekday in term time. Children can be booked to attend for any or all of these (subject to availability).

Funding: Government funding for children over 3 years old is 15 hrs per week. Working families can also get funding for 2 year olds. We do offer the extended 30-hour entitlement, but this is based on availability. We try to offer as many sessions as possible on a first come first served basis. Lunch: Children attending for the full day, or the afternoon session should bring a packed lunch.


Morning: 09:00 – 12:00

Parent / Carer Engagement We are always keen to engage our parents and carers in the development of their children. At Farnsfield Pre-School we use the following methods:

Journals

As part of our key-working process we record observations for our children in their personal journal. This is in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) requirements, but it also allows you to see what your children have been doing in the day and gives you the chance to tell us any WOW moments, or what your child has been doing at home. You can ask to see this at any time, and it is passed on to you when your child leaves us.

Closed Facebook page

Open to parents and carers of current children only. We upload pictures each day and share other information here. We will ask for your permission before we upload any pictures of your child, and no names are posted.

"PLEEEEASE can I go back tomorrow?" Pre-School provides a stimulating place for children to learn through play and expand their experiences between home and school. Activities are varied and imaginative, encouraging children to learn at their own pace, whilst still focussing on each child as an individual.

We offer a variety of extra activities such as:

- Sports Coaching
- Music & Movement
- Little Explorers
- Science and Technology
- Messy play

A day at Pre-School sessions typically includes song time, outdoor play, story time and snack, as well as free play. **But always includes loads of fun and learning.**

How your child will be learning?

At Farnsfield Pre-School we believe that children learn best through play. All our activities are designed to give children choice and stimulate every aspect of their development. We are confident that through play children have the very best opportunities to learn everything they need to about themselves and the world they live in. Play is children's work. Your child will be learning skills, acquiring knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through seven areas of learning and development. Each activity will be tailored to your child's unique needs, giving the opportunity to explore, be active and be creative using both the indoors and outdoors

Focus Areas and Leads

Safeguarding

Safeguarding is our number one priority and everyone's responsibility.

This is the responsibility of all staff and committee. *All new starters must read the 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' handbook*.

We discuss safeguarding in all of our committee meetings and share any further safeguarding guidance as this is received.

Special Education Needs (SENCO)

Every child is as individual and should be given the appropriate support to develop and fulfil their potential

The SENCO is a staff member at preschool who oversees the day-today provision for children with specia I educational needs.



Speech and Language

We believe that every child is a talker. Speech and language skills are the foundation of education. It's important that these skills be prioritised in the early years as that's when children begin forming their vocabulary

The Speech and Language Lead can identify when children might be having difficulty. They ensure all staff **receive adequate trai ning and understand how to support children**, making referrals to speech and language professionals where necessary.

Join the Committee:

The Pre-School is run by a voluntary management committee, who work together to manage and develop Pre-School. If you want to make Farnsfield Pre-School the best it can be then you are perfect. We pride ourselves on having a diverse range of skills in the committee, and joining the committee is a great way of meeting and connecting with other local parents who are passionate about Farnsfield, our Pre-School and our children. We really value everyone's input. You can be as involved as you like. We do love to have the full committee attend the committee meetings each half term, which are held in an evening.

Parent Helper:

We are proud of the high ratio of adults to children at the Pre-School. This ensures individual attention to the needs and development of each child. Parent helpers are welcome, and we encourage you to be part of your children's development by joining us for any session your child attends.

How can I get more involved?

The more the merrier!

Can I visit Pre-School before sending my child? Yes of course, just contact us and we will happily show you and your child around.

Does my child need to be toilet trained? No, we are able to change your child as needed. You will just need to send in sufficient nappies, wipes and bags.

What if my child has an accident as Pre-School? All our team are qualified in Paediatric First-Aid. Any accident is recorded in our accident book. We will take you through what happened when you collect your child and ask you to sign the accident book.

What if my child has allergies? Please let know on your registration forms. We will discuss our approach with you to ensure you are comfortable.

Can I see your policies? Yes, we operate under strict monitored policies that we would be happy to share with you.
